



Product: Color Rich Mulch

Product Description

Our earth-friendly, colorant enhanced mulch intensifies the color of natural Douglas Fir and Hardwood Bark, available in three colors, Brick Red, Dark Brown and Cherry Brown. The vibrant color lasts throughout the season.

Independent laboratory tests state Color Rich dyes are safe for shrubs, plants, pets and children. We use the same non-toxic materials to color our mulch as found in lipsticks, cosmetics, and food containers.

Uses: Residential and commercial landscapes. Where a rich, long-lasting, color is desired. Retains moisture in the soil and helps to control weeds when applied at 3-4" deep.

Application: Apply 3"-4" deep for new landscaped areas and 1"-2" for coloring established beds.

Specifications:

Screened at 5/8" minus (material size ranges from 1" down to fines). Brick Red uses Iron oxide-based colorant. Dark Brown (Black) uses carbon black-based colorant.

Cherry Brown uses both Iron oxide-based and carbon black-based colorants.

Preparation Checklist for Blower Service application

- • Turn off sprinkler system
- • Keep children and pets away from the blower operation
- • Remove vehicles from the blowing area
- • Cover swimming pools and ponds
- • Close all windows and doors and turn off- the air conditioning system
- • Consider having a Magic Eraser on hand for light stains
- • And last, but not least– please thoroughly remove all animal waste from the work area

Additional Application Information

Blower Service

- • May stain a structure if blown onto the side
- • May be tracked into the structure by people or pets
- • Blower hose end should be low to the ground, with air turned on as low as possible, and angled away from structures.
- • Never run water in conjunction with blower

Dumped Material

We strongly suggest laying a tarp down prior to dumping material

If light staining occurs, immediate treatment with a Magic Eraser may remove the stain.

Disclaimer

Like all landscape material that goes through a dye process, there is the possibility of stains on structures or concrete, or on flooring if tracked into a building.
